1. Entries close: 4. January 2010

2. Entry fees are as follows:

a/ Fee per animal:	5, 00 Euro
b/ Administration costs:	3, 50 Euro
c/ Selling cards:	2, 00 Euro
d/ Catalogue (1 for a family obliges)	10, 00 Euro

3. Participation

There can be exhibited by adult and youthful (4-18 years), which are member of a rural association which is affiliated with the EE. There can be showed: Netherland Dwarfs, Dwarfs with Fox or Satin fur, Polish (Dwarf hare), all in colours as recognised in the European standard or in the standard of with the EE affiliated country.

4. Exhibits are allowed as:

- Single entries
 - Collections (4 rabbits of the same breed and colour). In the collections both sexes must be represented.
- If an exhibitor sends in more than one collection then he/she must fill in these in its order on the entry form, desired by him. Therefore 4 animals= 1st collection, following 4 animals= 2nd collection, etc.

5. Marks off the animals

All exhibited animals must have permitted signs of at the EE affiliated country. For these signs apply the regulations of the individual EE countries.

6. Entries to

Entry forms are sent to the earlier-mentioned address. The entry must be filled in well readable, in block-system characters and in one of three EE-languages (German, French or English) with exception of The Netherlands. After the entry is closed later entries and changes cannot be accepted.

7. Terms of payment

The payment of the entry fees must be done normally up to 10 days after the entries have closed. The payment must take place preferably by means of bank transfer, but payment in cash during the show is also possible.

8. Catalogue

The catalogue is obliged for every exhibitor. To youthful applies that one catalogue by family is obliged.

9. Sale

Selling of animals is possible on 29 January 2010 from 8.30 till 21.30 and on 30th January 2010 from 8.30 till 16.00. Every exhibitor has the right to offer its animals for sale. One must buy for that a sale card (price 2 euro). The selling price must be indicated in Euro. The seller will receive 100% of this price. The purchaser has to pay an allowance of 10% on this price. Sold animals can be taken away on Friday 29 January 2010 from 17.00-18.00, and on Saturday 30 January 2010 from 13.00. The money of the sold animals will be paid to the exhibitors during the show (in the show-secretariat).

10. Europe-Champion

10.1. Single animals

The title Europe-Champion can be given following the rules for breed owned European shows point 10.2 of the following grounds to become:

- As at least 20 presented animals in each breed, which must come from at least 2 countries, the best rabbit will be awarded with the title Europe-Champion and will receive a golden EE medal.
- As a single colour to the previous conditions (10a) is satisfied (20 animals from 2 countries) it is possible that in the breed several Europe-Champion titles will be awarded.
- As there are registered more than 40 rabbits from 3 countries then become both the best male and the best female the title. This also applies to the different colours, as far as they satisfy to the conditions.
- For the title Europe-Champion a rabbit must be gained at least 96 points. The organisation has for the winners of this title a special document available.

10.2. Collections

For issue of the title Europe-Champion for collections for every breed must be presented at least 4 collections from at least 2 countries and at least 3 exhibitors must have sent in. If these conditions are reached in separate colours more Europe-Champion titles will be awarded. For the title a collection must be gained at least 372 points.

Exhibitors' medal

Each exhibitor, who has entered at least 4 exhibits, is entitled to the exhibitors' souvenir medal. This medal will be withheld if the exhibits are absent.

Donated special prices and cash prices

Donated special prices and cash prices can be listed on the entry form.



12. Catalogue and handing out of Awards

Prices, Catalogues and exhibitors medals for all exhibitors will be issued by the show organisers on the show-secretary. Prices, catalogues and medals not taken away from the show are not sent after.

13. Judging of exhibits

The rabbits will be judged according to the European standards. If a breed or colour has not been taken in this, the standard of the associated EE country applies.

14. Penning of exhibits

All exhibits can be penned on Wednesday 27 January 2010 from 18.00- 22.00. The exhibits can only be penned in under supervision. The exhibitor himself is responsible for taking away of the judging cards and the boxes of sold animals.

15. Liability

At matter of animal loss an appropriate compensation will be paid, if can be proven that the show organisers or their helpers are responsible. Each further compensation expires with that. At animal loss a written declaration with stamp and signed by the show president must be submitted. For losing of animals during the transport to and from the show, the organisation is not responsible and supplies no compensation.

16. Advertising and Photography

No advertising in the hall is allowed, unless prior approval from the show organisers has been obtained. Official animal photographers have to apply for a special written photography-permit from the show organisers. This permit will only be issued to accredited photographers who represent small livestock magazines. Applications must be sending at the latest on 4 January 2010 to the organisation. The time for photographing will be fixed by the show organisation. It is not allowed to visitors to open pen fronts in order to photograph exhibits.
